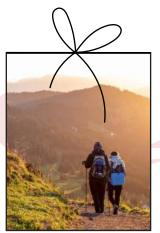

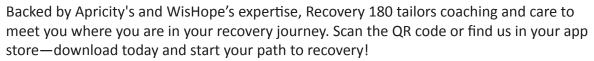
# The Daybreak Project – Support for Loved Ones of Those Facing Substance Use Disorders (SUD)

# The Gift of Recovery

All of Apricity's programs are designed to meet people wherever they are on their personal recovery journey.

Apricity's Residential Treatment (ART) includes both intensive and transitional residential, as well as semi-independent living treatment.

Apricity's Contract Packaging (ACP) is a recovery-supportive job training employment program.

**Sober Living (SL)** is a safe, recovery-supportive housing program.

Peer Recovery Programs (PRP) include recovery coach training and support

services for the community.
